

The map details the various walks some are shorter and some link up to form longer walks. The more ambitious of you who can manage a longer route, can see where Charles Darwin's HMS Beagle's last known resting place is .

Finding your way

Jubilee marsh trail

Jubilee marsh and the sea embankment are formed of the soil that Crossrail brought in from its tunnel excavation in London.

Sea water entered the marsh for the first time in July 2015. The 2.4km permissive trail leads to Half Moon viewpoint at the south of the Island overlooking the River Roach where you may see seals. Dogs are not permitted on this trail.

South trail

The South trail is a permissive route which links the south end of the Jubilee marsh trail to Marsh flats trail.

Due to the uneven nature of the seawall top, visitors should walk along at the bottom of the seawall but at various points there are good views across the River Roach to the south and the lagoons to the north. Dogs are not permitted on this trail.

Allfleets marsh trail

Enjoy the large skies and landscape of the Essex coast as you walk along this 3.2km trail.

South of the footpath you will see Pool marsh created in 2015 whilst to the north you will see Allfleets marsh created in 2006. The trail runs all the way to the northeastern corner of the reserve at School House viewpoint. This public footpath is the only trail that allows doos.

New pool trail

This permissive trail runs east to west across the middle of the reserve giving visitors excellent views of the southern lagoons.

Look across the adjacent grassland areas for hunting raptors in winter and singing farmland birds in summer. Dogs are not permitted on this trail.

Marsh flats trail

This permissive circular trail takes you past Grass Farm lagoon and Acresfleet lagoons, and then around the grazing marsh and wet grassland.

Water was let into the lagoons in autumn 2016 via a sluice in Alfleets marsh. The longer circular route is 4.4km and the shorter one is 1.5km. Dogs are not permitted on this trail.

Beagle trail

This trail leads you to the viewpoint over the River Roach and the final resting place of the Beagle.

Dogs are not permitted on this trail.
